<u>See a Movie, Help a Village!</u> If you go to see "Snow White and the Huntsman" (M) at Beverly Hills Cinema, at 7:00pm on Saturday 30 June, your money will help build a hostel for primary school children in ShangZhen!

The govt has provided school buildings, but no hostel. Little kids have to walk to school each day, up to 2 hours each way, and are subject to walking through snow in winter, wet grass in summer, insect and sometimes snake bites - they get sick and end up dropping out of school, because it's too far and too hard. WorldShare wants to build a hostel so they can stay at school during the week - in effect meaning they can actually get their education, and not be prevented by physical hardship.

Many of the older generation are illiterate - their hope is in the younger generation getting a better education and being able to get a better job than working the land.
