Over the years, they have helped establish partnerships to build schools, school hostels, water reservoirs, medical clinics, church buildings and train pastors. They also sponsor 160 children in the Yanbian region in far north-eastern China. Currently, they are promoting three key projects: Training and Sending Pastors,



AnLan Primary School Hostel (nearly completed) and the Disabled School Kitchen (also nearly completed). All of these projects are in Guangxi province where many short-term teams have visited. A&A Ministries also coordinates the English camps in Du'an as a part of their ministry.

Prayer Points for A&A Ministries:

- * Praise God for the 800 students who left the China English Camp with greater confidence to speak English, as well as a clear understanding of the gospel.
- * Praise that Alsie Ng led 16 of the hotel waitresses to the Lord.
- * Pray for Esther's new walk with Christ and her willingness to be involved with the local outreach work run by A&A Ministries. Pray that a suitable discipleship training course will become available to her.
- * Pray for wisdom and boldness for Esther and Pastor Lu in the establishment work at LaTeng Preaching Point.
- * Pray for the student workers AnJu, Pastor Lan and CunMiao, who are now managing the book café at Dali Bible College. Pray that this project will be a channel for the Lord's blessings to students who have come to understand His Word in the Bible.
