Below is a report on Sending and Training Outreach Workers for the DuAn region, from Alfred and Alsie Na, our ministry partners in China. Please pray for them and for the work that God is expanding.

Vision: To reach out to more than 100 villages under the governance of the DuAn County (establishing a PP in each of the villages reached) and to help bring up & support a total of 50 preachers within the 5 years period July 2010-June 2015.

Progress of Outreach Work:

- 1) Prior to July 2010: A total of 9 villages were reached: LaTeng, NongWen, ShangChao, MinShe, JiuTian, YanYang, JiaHe, JiLong and AnFu.
- 2) Year #1 (July 2010-June 2011): 13 more villages were subsequently reached. MeiDong, DeYa, GuSan, LaLie, BaiWang, JiaGui, SuoTan, LaRen, JiuDu, CongYue, BanMai, LonaZhona and XiaAo Villages.
- 3) Year #2 (July 2011-June 2012): 14 more new villages were added to the list:

i) XiaBa, AnLe (GanPeng) Villages & XiaAo Township by Lu FengQun & Liana YaoHui ii) ShangZhen, CongSan, LongFu (DaCona), LuSan, NonaMi & DiSu Village by Tang JinYing & WeiAiXiu

iii) JiaZuo Village by Lan YaoTian/Lan ZhenJiao

iv) TinaLv (BaShi) Village by Lan LiangHuan/Lan ZhongXu

v) GuChao & BaiHuang (NongKun) Villages by LuLu, Wei HaiHui & Wei RuiGao
