## Prayer Points from Kian Holik at UTS

Dear Friends.

What has happened in the last a couple of months reminds me of what happened when multitudes came to Christ in the beginning of the early church. After Jesus returned to heaven, the disciples knelt down and prayed to God (Acts 1:14). Soon, non believers came to believe in the name of Jesus. Similar things have happened for us.

- 1. **We had our biggest getaway ever** in the second weekend of August. 47 came to hear God's word delivered by Matthew Meek, focus national director. Praise God for some people who became very keen to learn from the Bible and came to our weekly meeting.
- 2. Just on Wednesday this week, we had our biggest outreach/ evangelism meeting, in which 52 people came to hear God's word. We flyered more than 200 postcards to invite people to come to our weekly meeting. About 15 of them were new comers. Please pray that we can faithfully follow them up.
- 3. We have more regular attendants in our small group, which range from 4-11 people in a group, spread around 7 different times in a week. Please pray for them that they can read the gospel of John and understood that Jesus is Christ, the Messiah.
- 4. Focus staff team has been praying for our leadership next year. Two staff workers are finishing at the end of the year, and that leaves just two of us for next year. We had been warned that it would take a very long time to get processed and hopefully approved, but we believe that God will make it beautiful in his time. Praise God for 2 student leaders who will be leading focus, but we are in need of small group Bible study leaders for next year.
