"I am your new confession of faith!" were the words Jakir, a devout Sasak Muslim man, heard Jesus speak to him in a dream. After a specific dream detailing baptism, Jakir awakened that same morning and took himself to the river. When he was sure that no one was around, he dunked himself under water.

A few weeks later Jakir still did not understand salvation in Jesus. Even so, he dreamt again of Jesus baptizing him. In obedience to this unknown God, he went down to the creek and knelt in the water and baptized himself again to make sure it was done properly.

Before he had these dreams, a church planting movement worker had shared with Jakir about the Saviour during multiple visits. He shared with him through Discovery Bible Study (DBS) stories, through the JESUS Film in Sasak, as well as a contextual movie entitled *"Irun's Dream."*

After Jakir truly acknowledged that salvation is through Christ alone, he wanted his friend to baptize him as the statement of his new heart condition!

Pray that God would continue to go ahead of and behind missionaries with undeniable signs and wonders that point to Jesus Christ. Pray that local and foreign missionaries will be filled with boldness to start more Discovery Bible Study story groups among Sasak households that will reproduce rapidly into a mighty movement to Christ.

(Currently in Lombok there are 2,600,000 Muslims, and only 100 Christian believers.)
