They said Yes! We went over to our dear friends Agus and Maena's house one night several weeks ago to share with them the last story in the chronological story set we've been using about Jesus. Moving Soon- South Lombok Project update It has begun! The south Lombok project began 1 week ago with the start of a survey of 21 small villages in one district. I (Andrew) have been travelling back and forth 2-3 days a week to coordinate the survey and make sure that the people we have trained to sur-vey are doing a good job. I have been amazed at the quality of the surveyors who are local men and women and see the blessing of God on this project.

Inspiration- DMM conference We spent the first week of November in Bali. I (Julie) helped facil-itate worship at a conference for women interested in learning more about how to start a DMM (Disciple Making Movement). It was really inspiring to be learning and sharing with 100 women serving in several countries and passionate about reaching others. I was really sick for most of the week but felt that I needed to persevere.

We went out 2 by 2 in the afternoons and many came back with amazing stories of how our heavenly Father had prepared hearts to hear about him. I was privileged to share with a young mother who has suffered rejection from her family since she was young. I shared from the word and we cried together. I tried to see her again but it didn't work out. Please pray that our loving Father would send someone to follow up who lives in her area.

As a result of this training, a number of us have been re-energised to take the next steps with people we know who are open. I am very excit-ed to have begun chronological stories with my helper. She is very cluey and is sharing with her husband.

Answered prayer
