Pray for our response to Domestic Violence

Join us for a half-day conference concerning domestic violence within the church and the wider community, to be held at St Anne's Anglican Church, Ryde (Cnr Victoria Rd and Church St) on November 22, from 10am to 1pm.

"Domestic violence is a widespread though often hidden problem across Australia. It occurs in all parts of society, regardless of geographic location, socioeconomic status, age, cultural and ethnic background, or religious belief, and its often devastating effects — psychological, social and economic, short-term and long-term — rebound on families, children, and the community as a whole." (source www.whiteribbon.org.au _ fact sheets 6 and 10)

These unsafe relationships are part of family life for many couples and families in the church. How can we as Christians respond to this?

Family dispute resolution expert, **Jon Graham**, will address the conference on unsafe and unhealthy relationships. Following Jon's keynote address there will be three parallel sessions. Baptist LifeCare Manager, **Rev Tibor Mo**kany will present on programs available to domestic violence perpetrators and victims. Child Consultant, **Lynda Dunstan**, has been invited to discuss the impact of family violence and abusive relationships on children. ANGLICARE social worker and relationship counsellor, **Maria Orr**, has been invited to give guidance on what to do if someone tells you they are in an abusive relationship.

The conference aims to empower Christians to identify and address domestic violence within the church and the wider community.
