

Thank you: First of all, thank you for faithfully standing behind this strategic ministrysome of you for many years. It's incredibly encouraging to me to know that there is a whole group who is part of what I am doing week by week at school. I am looking forward to hopefully meeting you all, as I come to speak at each of the churches.

SRE Big Picture: The first term has gone well. The days have been full of teaching, preparing, organising, meeting lots of new people and generally becoming part of the school community. The staff has been warm, welcoming and supportive, which is a lovely blessing.

Lessons have got off to a good start. Altogether SRE lessons reach about 370-380 girls per fortnight from a wide range of nationalities, religions and family situations. (incl Chinese, Philippine, Malaysian, Korean, British, Greek, Macedonian, Tongan, Samoan, US, Nepalese, Indian, Bangladeshi, Spanish..... Christian, Jew, Buddhist, Muslim, Hindu, Mormon).

Some girls love having SRE, others begrudge the lesson. Some listen keenly, others love to disrupt. Some are thinking lots and asking great questions, others are passive. But there have been some great moments in these lessons where little bit, by little bit some of God's amazing gospel is being comprehended by some of the students. Seminars have also started. A Moore College team (attached to St Aidan's) ran the first seminar of the year for the Year 10s (March 26<sup>th</sup>) and the gospel was presented clearly and warmly.

ISCF has been given permission to continue and will start in Term 2. I am looking forward to the opportunity of encouraging the girls who come along.
