- It has been good to return this year and feel part of the school, to know most of the girls' faces and many of their names. I also feel blessed to be part of a staff that is friendly and welcoming.
- I continue to love teaching the truths of the gospel to the girls day by day and answering questions of all sorts. It is a privilege and a joy.
- ISCF has kicked off for the new year. There are between 14-17 girls who have been coming along on Friday lunchtimes. There is a lovely warmth. I have taken their questions (written in the first meeting this year) to form the basis of the short Bible talks this term.
- Oatley ISCF is, God-willing, starting 17 March. I have met the Deputy and she is happy for the group to be advertised and has organised a room. Matt Harris (SRE Peakhurst), Matt Dickens (SRE Hurstville Boys') and I will lead the group. The plan at this stage is for it to meet each fortnight.

#### Challenges:

It has been sad to see the numbers of girls doing SRE drop.

Please pray that the opportunity of being at PGC would continue, and especially that the Holy Spirit would open hearts to see Jesus in the glory of his grace. Currently about 55% girls in Yrs 7- 9 participate.
