## Pray for Michael Duckett and the MacArthur Indigenous Church

Michael's Studies: Ten years ago, during my employment interview, Al Stewart (previous Bishop) encouraged me to do further biblical studies to enhance my ministry skills and knowledge. I was reluctant but agreed to do it with the support of the Bishop. I now rejoice as I have finally obtained a Master of Arts in Theology from Sydney Missionary & Bible College. I give thanks to God for working through the Wollongong Anglican Regional Office to assist me to continue to develop my skills to correctly handle the word of God.

**National Reconciliation Week** (NRW) runs annually from 27 May -3 June. The 2017 theme was 'Let's Take the Next Steps'. These dates mark two milestones in Australia's reconciliation journey: 1) 50 years since the 1967 referendum where Aboriginal people were recognized; 2) 25 years since the historic Mabo decision. May God lead this country in the next steps of our nation's reconciliation journey, as we call all people and nations to be reconciled to God, so we then learn how to be reconciled to our neighbour. Our church is driven by God's call for all humankind to be reconciled to himself through his Son Jesus Christ.

**Preaching:** Early this year the Macarthur Indigenous Church began following the same sermon series as Campbelltown Anglican Church to strengthen the unity between the two churches and enhance reconciliation between the two. It also enables the whole ministry team to support each other with back up preaching which has already benefited the Aboriginal church while Michael was away.

#### PRAYER POINTS

- We thank God for the increase over the years and how we now have more men than women in church.
- We rejoice and thank God for the privilege of allowing our church opportunities to demonstrate the reality of reconciliation in our community.
- We thank God for working through the Wollongong Anglican Regional Office for supporting Pastor Michael Duckett to obtain a Master of Arts in Theology.
- Pray with us as we continue to trust God for the provisions needed for the ministry as he has always done; even though we keep falling short, God has always provided.
- ♦ With the considerable reduction of funding available from the Sydney Anglican Indigenous People's Ministry Committee, we now have a ministry shortfall of approx. \$30,000. Raising this \$30,000 is a significant challenge and places pressure on our 2017 budget but as always we walk by faith thanking God for his provisions and faithfulness.
