Fun times in the USA- We have been privileged to spend the past 2 ½ months travelling to the other side of the world. Thanks to your prayers our boys loved flying on so many planes. We attended a powerful time of prayer for the cousin world and were blessed by new relationships with like-minded people. It was great to see friends and family. We had a lot of fun! Isaac loved getting to speak ENGLISH with everyone. He was sad to have to leave his new friends, but happy to come back to his old ones in Lombok.

Reentry - It never seems to be easy to go between different cultures, but getting back to Lombok during Ramadan (the fasting month) really hurt. The differences in humidity, disruption in lifestyle and oppressive spiritual atmosphere were shocking to us. In the midst of that, we also experienced great joy with many of our friends coming and visiting. Our friends Agus and Maena came over for a time of breaking the fast together, and we had a deep connection talking about and rejoicing in "the Savior." As Paul said to the Thessalonians, "For what is our hope or joy or crown of boasting before our Lord Jesus at his coming? Is it not you? (I Thess. 2:19)".

Buying Land in Selong Belanak- We are excited about our new plan to buy land in Selong Belanak (where we used to live). It's been on our hearts for a long time as we have wanted long term involvement in the region. This budding tourist region is perfect for investment, and eventually we can open a small backpackers' homestay. We have already received several gifts that will go towards buying a small plot and building a local style house in the village. Please pray that the right piece of land will become available for a fair price and that logistics are processed smoothly.

The Season Ahead- There are many things we are continuing to look forward to: continued discipleship of Norm, working with surfers in our community, continuing relationships with our friends in South Lombok, engaging with mothers in our community, and so much more! Andrew is going to be diving into his business work here as well. Julie is still praying about what she should focus on now that the boys are getting bigger. We so desire to see transformation among the people here! It's only because of His work. Please join us in praying that His kingdom would come and His will would be done here.
