Pray for SRE (Special Religious Education) in Penshurst Primary School

(Below is a letter from Mark Fitzgerald, Protestant SRE Coordinator at Penshurst Primary School.)

This letter updates my letter of 20 February, 2017. The prayer request in that letter for a Year 1 and 2 Scripture Teacher was answered when a local church's youth pastor accepted this position. Please pray for Michael Unsworth in his new role.

This week we begin Term 3. As you may know, SRE in NSW State Schools retains its place in the school timetable thanks to many positive submissions to the State SRE Review Panel. Penshurst Public School offers scripture classes to children from Protestant, Catholic, Moslem, Buddhist and Church of the Living God backgrounds, and to any child whose parents wish to enrol them.

In the last 3-4 years, Protestant student numbers have decreased while other groups have seen an increase. This decline means that we now operate three combined classes: Year 1 with Year 2, Year 3 with Year 4, and Year 5 with Year 6. Combining classes has made it much more difficult for out teachers who now have to provide a two-year cycle of material to keep the students from repeating it each year. Nevertheless, the classes are working well, with three of the teachers being local ministers (Bart Vandenhengel, Aisen Ju and Michael Unsworth.) Kindergarten, taught by Mark Fitzgerald, continues on its own.

Please pray that the Kindergarten enrolments for next year will be maintained or increase. Enrolments are being encouraged now, with formal enrolments taking place from October, when parents attend the first school welcome day for 2018. Pray also for Mark Fitzgerald as he presents the work of Protestant Scripture to these new parents.
