

Pray for NIGERIA

FAMINE- The famine in Nigeria is part of the worst humanitarian crisis since World War II according to the UN. But it's not caused by a natural disaster. **It's caused by war**, and Christians in Nigeria are among those suffering the most. Islamic extremist group *Boko Haram* tried taking over in 2009. They later pledged allegiance to the Islamic State. Many have been forced to flee their homes and live in makeshift camps.

GOD AT WORK- Christians in Nigeria are being excluded from receiving aid, simply because of their faith in Jesus. Because of your support, Open Doors has been able to provide food for 15,000 families – that's 75,000 people! And it's all been done through the local church, because we believe we're not the answer, Jesus is. "Supporters won't believe what this help means to us all...We give thanks to God for you... These are the things that keep the light of God shining in [northern Nigeria]. We are the messengers to them of the love of all of you praying for us and supporting us in this relief effort." - Open Doors local partner in Nigeria.

•Pray that Christians will continue to hold onto Jesus despite the persecution and hunger.

•Pray for their persecutors to know God's love for them, and for their salvation.

•Pray that the gospel will continue to spread in Nigeria and that the church will continue to be light in the darkness.
