


Pray for Muslims During Ramadan

The Muslim month of fasting known as **Ramadan** begins on May 15th.

During this time, many Muslims are earnestly seeking God.

Would you commit to praying for the Islamic world?

Monday: "And afterward, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions." (Joel 2:28) Intercede for Muslims that God might reveal himself through dreams and visions.

Tuesday: "I am the bread of life; he who comes to Me will not hunger, and he who believes in Me will never thirst." (John 6:35) Pray for Muslims as they experience hunger and thirst. Pray that this would prompt them to hunger and thirst for Jesus, the bread of heaven, and for His living water.

Wednesday: "Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer." (Romans 12:12) Give thanks for Muslim-background believers who have come to faith in the Lord Jesus. Pray that they might have endurance to persevere despite opposition. Pray for protection from the evil one.

Thursday: "I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people— for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness." (1 Timothy 2:1-2) Pray especially for the salvation of Muslims that hold positions of leadership, including clerics and imams.

Friday: "But as for me, I watch in hope for the LORD, I wait for God my Saviour; my God will hear me." (Micah 7:7) Many Muslim-majority countries are experiencing instability, war and conflict, food shortages and famine. Pray for God's peace to bring an end to bloodshed.

Saturday: "You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden." (Matthew 5:14) Pray for Christian workers in Muslim communities where Christ is least known, that they would be faithful in proclaiming the Gospel message in a way which addresses the felt needs of Muslims.

Sunday: "Don't you have a saying, 'It's still four months until harvest'? I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest." (John 4:35) Pray for Muslims here in Australia. Pray that Christians would be effective and intentional in reaching out to Muslim friends and neighbours through the building of genuine relationships. Give thanks for how God is already at work!
