# Pray for Rain—Sunday 1 July 2018

Dear Praying Friends,

The ongoing drought in the Darling Downs and South West Queensland, as well as in many other regions of Australia, is causing major difficulties and strains in our communities. The lack of rain during Summer, Autumn and now Winter is causing major financial stresses as well as significant mental health concerns for farmers, their families and local communities in our regions.

It is fair to say that the greater portion of arable land Australia-wide is suffering from drought at various levels. The drought has been particularly severe in Northern NSW and Southern Queensland with some areas experiencing their **lowest rainfall recorded** for this period since records were started.

The National Call for a 'Day of Prayer for Rain' on Sunday 1st July has been initiated and led by Toowoomba Mayor Paul Antonio and was unanimously passed by 11 Lord Mayors from Southern Queensland on Friday 22 June, who were meeting in drought affected Charleville. Yes, this is very short notice, but sometimes you have to grab the opportunity for prayer when it comes. The drought situation in Australia requires our urgent prayers and compassionate attention.

On behalf of the Mayors of the Darling Downs and South West Queensland, can I strongly encourage you and your churches to commit time on July 1 to pray for rain for our region. The need is dire, yet God is the provider of all our needs. Let us seek God and pray for the blessing of rain for our land.
