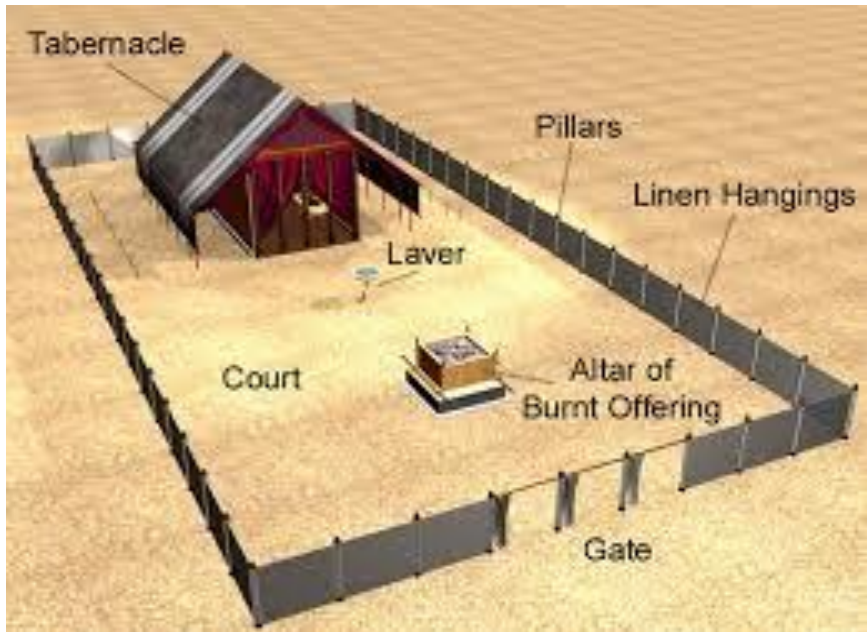

Dear Praying Friends -

We've recently learned that several villages in Nigeria surrounding the city of Jos were attacked in a three-day killing spree led by Muslim Fulani militant herdsman. As many as 200 Christians have been murdered. The attacks began Thursday and ended Sunday evening. Currently, the area is under a dusk-'til-dawn curfew.



Please pray for Bart's friends in Jos, **Gloria and Archbishop Ben Kwashi**. This was the third time that Muslims have attacked their home. The first time they stole his cattle. The second time they came to kill him. He was gone and so they savaged his wife, assaulting her womanhood, and left her half-dead. Last night all of his cattle were stolen. When his dear neighbour Ayuba heard and shined a light on the rustlers, he was shot dead.

Archbishop Kwashi joked that, like Paul in Philippians 1, he thinks God wants him to continue living on this earth because God has more for him to do. Ben may well be the most powerful Anglican leader in the world, since he was just announced in Jerusalem last week as the new General Secretary of GAFCON (Global Anglican Future Conference).

Dear God, we pray for these believers who have been through so much. We ask that You would restore calm and comfort those who have lost loved ones, being near to the broken-hearted. And we pray that these attackers would be quickly brought to justice. We ask You to strengthen the church in Jos to be light in the darkness. Amen.
