

This next series of sermons seeks to answer those important questions.



Earthquakes- As you know by now, Lombok was rocked by a series of devastating earthquakes that killed over 500 people and forced hundreds of thousands of people to live outside. Although we weren't hurt and our house is fine, one of our neighbours died when her mother's "warung" at the beach collapsed. Emotionally, we have been pretty drained as we care for people, organize relief efforts and try to continue our normal lives of school and work. Please pray for all the people affected. Pray also for us as we live our lives in the middle of chaos. We still have several different ideas about how to help, but we need incredible wisdom from God to not spread ourselves too thin! On a positive note, through this earthquake Special K has been able to reconnect with his cousin who is in the earthquake zone. This guy whom I will call "Lucky" already heard the Gospel from K ages ago. When we showed up at his house, he wanted to hear more. Now he is a believer and was "dunked" recently. He really is a Lucky guy!

Hammer is a believer!- Hammer, a surfer and fisherman, has been a staple around our house. We've probably surfed 100 times together and gone on countless trips. During these times I've tried to talk to him about JC and given a ton of marriage advice. Although he didn't seem to understand any of it, he kept showing up to our house fellowship and really enjoyed the community. He ended up having a dream where a big wave was coming at him and he said the name "Jesus" and the wave stopped! So, when Special K and I sat down with him and intentionally talked with him about following JC, he said yes and confessed some deep sins and things that have caused him incredible shame. He has an incredibly long way to go in the ways of discipleship, and he has moved to a different part of the island so please pray that he can be discipled well.

Prayer trip to BM- During the last week of the kids' school break, we did a crazy, exhausting, fun and adventurous trip. I (Andrew) had a dream about BM a few months ago and felt that God was directing us to visit. The 2 places in BM that I dreamed of were exactly as in the dream, and we felt that God moved powerfully as we prayed and worshipped at these sites. I felt that God was giving us vision for a long-term person or family to minister there.

Transition back to school- The boys have done a great job making friends and adjusting to a new school. After a bumpy start, they had a great week of classes before the earthquakes hit. Since then we have had school on and off outside.
