# Pray for David Lakos

Hospital chaplains constantly encounter people seeking hope in their life. Amid the travails of illness people seek an attentive person, and chaplains are that listening and caring person during this time. Chaplains are the ones who pray, who bring the scriptures to deepen an understanding, and to comfort those who need the assurance that God is actually with them in the vicissitudes of life.

# Prayer points.

- Pray that the chaplains will be careful and attentive listeners who can sensitively respond with grace and love.
- Pray that the chaplains will be strengthened by the Lord in a ministry which is draining and often intense.
- Pray that the chaplains will be salt and light in the public hospital system.
- Pray that the "bread and butter" work of our chaplains as we visit in the hospital wards—that God will give us opportunities to offer comfort, forgiveness and hope in the name of Jesus.
- Pray for continuing growth and learning for our 5 excellent new volunteer chaptains (as we're thanking God for sending them to us!
- Pray for God's sustaining, equipping and refreshment for our chaplains, as they feel the impact of spending time each week with people in pain and distress
- Pray for our team's overnight retreat this week (24-26 October
- Pray for continuing good relationships and good reputation with hospital staff and management
