- We have finalised new Bible study resources to help congregations engage with God's heart for the poor and how this fits into a biblical worldview! - Anglicare recently has won government support to develop new affordable housing – a big boost in an area of need we have been addressing on a smaller scale already. Over coming years, this will enable us to support many of society's most vulnerable, working closely with local churches to create warm connections and loving, supportive communities.
- Please encourage prayerful support for our work among your congregations, that we might fulfil our mission of serving people in need, enriching lives, sharing the love of Jesus.
- As always, we are keen to partner with local churches to enable local mission

 for example through ESL classes, our expanding Mobile Community Pantry, short courses and seminars in Parenting and Family Skills, help and training to appropriately respond to Domestic Violence, provision of formal Mental Health First Aid training, equipping the saints through Introductory Pastoral Care Courses or perhaps something completely different, in response to the needs and opportunities in your community.
