Pray for HEAL Africa

Our Partnership with HEAL Africa : HEAL Africa has been bringing healing and hope to the Goma region of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) since 1996. What began as a small teaching hospital has grown into one of only three referral hospitals in all of the DRC. Moreover, the organisation has evolved beyond the hospital towards a more holistic approach, with 80% of their current work being community development programs focussed on health, education and spiritual welfare.



Our Church has been supporting the work of HEAL Africa chaplains for several years.

Patients at the HEAL Africa hospital represent some of the most vulnerable people in a region devastated by ongoing conflict and poverty. Illness and injury is often followed by psychological trauma from violence, abuse or neglect. As part of HEAL Africa's holistic approach to health care, the hospital has Chaplains that provide additional care and spiritual support for patients. This program also

trains male and female Chaplains to provide spiritual care in prisons, schools, hospitals and churches across the region. These Chaplains are working daily to bring healing and restoration to the broken hearts and traumatised minds of some of the world's most vulnerable people.

Chaplaincy Program Impact Report

Give thanks to God that, so far this year:

- HEAL Africa Chaplains have visited 4,772 hospital patients.
- Approximately 600 children attend Sunday School led by the Chaplains each Sunday. 56 people credit these 'classes' for them becoming believers.
- HEAL Africa Chaplains host two morning devotionals and two services each week and have reached 500 patients, staff and community members through these.
- 40 people have been Baptised and 4 couples married.
- 14 Chaplains completed the 40 day intensive chaplaincy school.- 1 of these Chaplains has been appointed to train other pastors in Chad on clinical pastoral care. - 4 were directly involved in dealing with trauma related to the Ebola outbreak. - 5 have started working as Chaplains in schools or colleges.- 4 are working in churches.

Cell Groups at Penshurst Anglican Church

Our church calls itself a 'cell church', built upon the Biblical idea that the primary way that God's people can truly live out the Gospel is through small, intentional communities (called 'cells'). It is here where Jesus is given a far more intimate opportunity to do His work of transformation.
