Our church vision- *“Reconcile all people to God through Christ”* (2 Cor. 5:15-16)

Sorry Business -In the last six months I (Michael Duckett) have participated in three funerals (Woronora Crematorium, Bowraville Cemetery, Ruse Catholic Church) spreading over large geographical distances that highlight how Aboriginal ministry is never restricted by boundaries.

Community Social and Emotional Wellbeing - I've ministered to a number of palliative care patients and their families throughout our community as well as holding a community luncheon each Monday to bless and walk with those who often will not enter the doors of a church.

Broader Church and Community Connections: Gerringong Anglican, Nowra Anglican, Thirroul Anglican, Menangle Anglican, St Peter's Anglican, Austinmer Anglican, Ruse Catholic Church, Donald Robinson Retirement Village, Mt Druitt Anglicare, Campbelltown and Camden Shire Councils.

Within the last 6 months, we have connected with the following numbers:

Adults: 398 people

Children and Young People: 1,145

People in general gatherings with mixed ages: 630

Overall total: 2,173

The goal in all of our ministry activities is to meet people where they feel safe and to walk with them in their journey to assist in a healthier social and emotional wellbeing which is ultimately found in Jesus Christ.
